Work experience

- **Events management & Social Media** -
 - I was a member of the AUB Zine Society committee acting as social media officer. I kept a close connection between the society and society members through our social media accounts and made connections that led to collaborative projects. I developed my team-working skills by contributing to the set-up of weekly sessions as well as the management, production and distribution of the zines we made. We made multiple zines in collaboration with other university societies and independent companies outside of the university.
 - I also took on the leading role in my Illustration course's 'Instagram take-over' wherein I created and posted promotional material for our Summer Grad Show viewing, which included posting my colleagues' work as well as documenting our course fundraiser and setting up the studio in preparation for the show, all on the AUB Illustration account.
- **Shop assistant** - Both volunteered and worked at a zero-waste store for a few days, helping to set up the shop after a renovation, tending to customers, restocking and cleaning.
- **Designer** - Completed a placement in the Graphics department of Fubra Limited, a website host and digital publisher, based in Aldershot, Hampshire. Created various designs which included creating logos for the company's Twitter account profile pictures, which they subsequently used. Learned how to work to the brief they would give me every day and learned how to talk about my ideas and work to others.
- **Team work/marketing** - Joined a six-week marketing group where we worked on a campaign to promote a local artist through social media and blogging sites for their performance at our local theatre. This gave me more experience with working in a team and with the marketing world.
- **Volunteering** - Did voluntary work to promote mental health awareness during National Citizenship Service and did other types of voluntary work when working towards the Girl Guiding Baden-Powell Award, including assisting in Rainbows' weekly meetings.
- **Collaboration** - Led a campaign to release my zine 'The Green Zeen', a spread of which featured low-waste shop Just1Swap in Boscombe, and created a bundle of goodies with artist Rosemary Chea (@illuroses) to be sold alongside it. Also helped to run, create and release multiple collaborative zines with AUB Zine Society and helped run markets and fairs to sell our work. Now currently in the process of setting up a new zine society with fellow graduates.
